Maximum Award: \$1,000 (\$500 per Semester)

Kevin & Kenya M. Faulkner Scholarship. The purpose of this scholarship is to acknowledge the need to support BETHLEHEM BAPTIST CHURCH students and to applaud their academic success and community involvement. This scholarship is structured to encourage and motivate students to reach higher levels of achievement. The scholarship will be awarded to one student who has the potential for high academic achievement during their undergraduate career. The student must also display leadership skills both on and off campus. In addition, the student must demonstrate financial need in order to continue studies.

Criteria:

- Student must be a full-time undergraduate student.
- Student must come from a single-parent home (mother, father or grandparent);
- Applicant is required to have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5;
- Classification requirement of a sophomore, junior or senior and having satisfactorily completed a minimum of 30 credits hours;
- Student must demonstrate financial need;
- Student must not have received any university judicial infractions;
- Student must demonstrate on- or off-campus community service involvement.

Student Requirements:

- Complete the O. Kevin & Kenya M. Faulkner Scholarship application form.
- Submit a typewritten essay (no less than 700 words) on ONE of the following topics:
 - **Choice of Heroes (Persuasive)** What does our choice of heroes, mentors, and role models — or the lack of heroes, mentors, and role models — reveal about our society and ourselves? *Use reasons and/or examples from your own reading, experience or observations to support your position.*
 - **Community Service (Persuasive)** Some people have suggested that everyone between the ages of 18 and 21 should be required to perform one year of community or government service, such as in the Peace Corps, Environmental Conservancy Corps, a hospital, the military, a rural or inner-city school, or other community outreach projects. *Should government or community service be required of 18- to 21-year-olds? Support your point of view with reasons from your own experiences, observations or reading.*
- Submit a letter of recommendation from someone who can attest to the student’s on- or off-campus community service participation.
