SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES:

The Viola Birdsong Scholarship was established in 2010 to honor Mrs. Birdsong who served the ministry tirelessly for many years and remains a faithful member of Bethlehem Baptist Church today.

The scholarship is targeted to a high school graduate who meets high school GPA minimums and plans on attending an accredited college/university in the fall of 2010. The recipient should also have an interest in majoring in general or corporate finance, administrative, project management, accounting, marketing, economics, banking, or general business. See additional "Eligibility Requirements" below. Awarding of scholarship is not based on financial need.

The scholarship award is a one-time award of \$500.00.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Recipients of the Viola Birdsong Trustee Emeritus Scholarship should:

- A. Be a high school graduate as of June 30th, 2010, in "good standing" with Bethlehem Baptist Church for at least the past 2 years
- B. Demonstrate some activity, ideally in a leadership role, in church ministries
- C. Have a cumulative High School GPA of 3.4 (based on 4.0 scale) or 85.0 (based on 100.0 scale)
- D. Have proof of college acceptance
- E. Has demonstrated a desire in majoring in general or corporate finance, administrative, project management, accounting, marketing, economics, banking, or general business.
- F. Complete the personal data section of application
- G. Submit 300-word essay on "What Does Stewardship Mean to Me and how should 'stewardship living' affect my life"?
